

4-H Policy Regarding School Enrichment Materials

Collier County University Extension has worked with the Collier County School District for many years. Extension Connection describes 4-H curricula and activities available for classroom use. All curricula meets the Sunshine State Standards.

- When using 4-H materials in the classroom, the project must be identified as a 4-H project to the children.
- Children are enrolled as classroom members of 4-H and are eligible to participate in 4-H competitive events, camp, the Collier County Fair, and traditional 4-H clubs. They are not obligated in any way.
- Children may receive 4-H project certificates of completion if requested by the teacher.
