February	beans (bush, pole & lima), beets, carrots, cantaloupe, collards, corn, cucumbers, eggplant, kohlrabi, mustard, okra, onions (bunch & multiplier), peas (english & southern), peppers, sweet potatoes, pumpkin, radish, squash (summer & winter), tomatoes (stake & ground), turnips, watermelon (sm, lg & seedless).
March	beans (bush, pole, lima), cantaloupe, corn, cucumber, mustard, okra, onions (bunch & multiplier), peas (southern), peppers, spinach, summer squash, tomatoes (stake & ground).
April	beans (bush, pole, lima), okra, peas (southern), potatoes (sweet)
May	okra, sweet potatoes
June	sweet potatoes

August	beans (pole, lima), cantaloupe, collards, corn, eggplant, okra, peas (southern) peppers, pumpkin, tomatoes (stake & ground), watermelon (small, large, seedless).
September	beans (bush, pole, lima), broccoli, cabbage, cantaloupe, collards, corn, cucumber, eggplant, endive, kale, lettuce, mustard, onions (bulb, bunch & multiplier), okra, parsley, peas (english), potatoes, pumpkin, squash (summer & winter), tomatoes (stake & ground), watermelon (small, large, seedless).
October	beans (bush, pole, lima), beets, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrots, cauliflowers, celery, collards, corn, cucumbers, eggplant, endive, kahe, kohlrabi, leek, lettuce, mustard, onions (bulb, bunch, multiplier), parsley, peas (english & southern), peppers, potatoes, radish, spinach, squash (summer) strawberry (plants not seeds), tomatoes (stake & ground), turnips.
